Mr. R. F. Stocek received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Wildlife Management from the University of Maine in 1959. He subsequently received a Master of Science Degree from the University of Toronto in Fishery Biology. From June, 1962, to September, 1965, Mr. Stocek was Manager of the Tinicum Wildlife Preserve and during part of this time was a member of the Delaware Valley Ornithological Club. Following doctoral work in wildlife ecology at the University of Western Ontario, Mr. Stocek became, in 1968, Program Director, Fish and Wildlife Management, at the Maritime Forest Ranger School at the University of New Brunswick.

John C. Miller joined the D.V.O.C. in 1951. His other affiliations include the Hawk Mountain Sanctuary Association, Eastern Bird Banding Association, Inland Bird Banding Association, and National Audubon Society.
